

Salesian Family Saints

Fr Augustus Czartoryski (1858-1893)



Augustus was born in Paris on August 2, 1858. His parents were Prince Ladislaus and Princess Maria Amparo, daughter of the Queen of Spain. When Augustus turned six his mother died. He carried out his studies in Paris and Cracow.

He was impressed by the character and mission of Don Bosco, and felt the desire to become a Salesian. He went on believing in his wish, despite strong opposition from his father.

He was educated and deeply influenced by Joseph Kalinowski, an outstanding personality who endured ten years of forced labour in Siberia and later became a Carmelite.

Augustus overcame his father's opposition and after consulting Pope Leo XIII, he renounced his rights as eldest son and travelled to Turin. He was twenty-nine years old and, despite his poor health, adapted himself well to the rigorous conditions of the Salesian novitiate. His religious clothing were blessed by Don Bosco himself in 1887. During his philosophy studies Augustus became ill.

Ordained a priest on April 2, 1892, his health rapidly worsened. He accepted his illness and generously offered his suffering to God for the welfare of needy youth.

His characteristic virtues as a Salesian were humility, obedience and the spirit of poverty.

He died at the age thirty-five in Alassio on April 9, 1893. His remains are venerated at Przemysl, Poland.
