**Bestselling Author, Rwandan Genocide Survivor to Speak in King City**

**Immaculée Ilibagiza**, New York Times bestselling author and Rwandan genocide survivor is coming to King City to speak about Faith, Hope, Love and Forgiveness at Our Lady of Grace Shrine at Marylake. Immaculée survived the 1994 genocide by hiding in a cramped bathroom with seven other women for three months; lost 60 pounds in the process and knew her entire family had been slaughtered in the killing spree. Despite this, Immaculée was able to forgive her tormentors and her family's murderers and even taught herself English while in the bathroom using a dictionary and a bible. After the genocide, she used the English she taught herself to secure herself a job at the United Nations.

Immaculée's first book, *Left to Tell; Discovering God Amidst the Rwandan Holocaust* was released in March 2006 and became a New York Times Best Seller. 60 Minutes has featured her story along with CNN, EWTN, The New York Times, USA Today and Newsday.

Immaculée will be at Our Lady of Grace Shrine at Marylake for two special speaking engagements.
