YEARLY REPORT - KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

In the 5 short years of presence at the parish, our St. John Bosco Council has been an integral part of the community. In the last year alone we conducted many social events, distributed a free calendar to families and offered financial and physical support for a number of causes in the parish and community at large including, the parish Capital Campaign, church maintenance, Summer Daze, Salesian Summerfest, Squires, St. Vincent de Paul, St. Francis Table, the Arthritis Society, the Iraqi Refugee Program and other families in need. They sponsored studies for two seminarians and provided the parish with the 3 new altar missals. Fostering a culture of life, the Knights supported 40 Days for Life, Campaign Life Coalition, Birthright International and Right to Life. They also sponsored a bus to Ottawa for March for Life. More recently, they spearheaded a soon-to-be-launched program for a defibrillator in the parish.

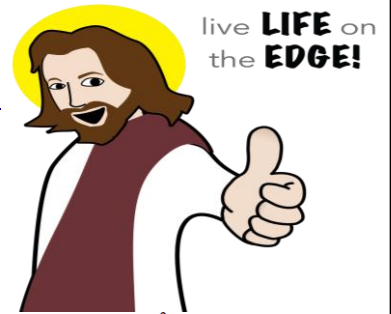
