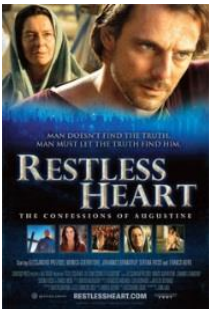
Bring your favourite cultural food: appetizer, main course or dessert. Label the underside of your platter with your name and phone number if you want it back.

Multiple mass intentions; up to 10 intentions

2nd, 3rd & 4th Tuesday of the month~7:30 pm Mass

ONE intention per Mass

You may request up to 5 Masses in a given year

**UNANNOUNCED MASS INTENTION \$10 OFFERING
For the Living and Deceased**

Mass intention is recorded and that intention is offered at a privately celebrated Mass. A card is included upon request.

Perpetual Mass Enrolment \$18 OFFERING

For all occasions: Birthdays, Anniversaries, First Communion, Confirmation, Get Well, Thinking of You, etc.
