

VIII. Music

To respect the liturgy, music for your wedding mass or ceremony must be **liturgical** music. A wedding liturgy is an occasion for the entire faith community to praise God. Yes, it's your wedding, but the liturgical moment has a unique beauty and characteristic: it directs our minds and hearts to the praise of God as the source and destination of all human love. The rest of the day will provide ample opportunity for romantic or secular songs.

For all music arrangements, contact must be made with the parish wedding coordinator.

Music chosen must be within the liturgical realm which means God themed or completely classical.

Music selections prior to weddings will need to be parish approved.
