IV. Mass or Ceremony

A wedding day is a day to celebrate all that unites the couple in a real and meaningful way. It is certainly not a time to draw attention to differences. From this, some consequences flow.

- For two **ROMAN CATHOLICS**, who **PRACTICE** their faith and attend mass regularly, the marriage normally takes place within the celebration of the **EUCHARIST (MASS)**.
- For two **ROMAN CATHOLIC** who do **NOT PRACTICE** their faith or who do not attend mass on a regular basis, it is more coherent with the couple's lifestyle to celebrate the marriage within a **LITURGY OF THE WORD** and not mass.
- If one spouse is **Non-Catholic**, the wedding is celebrated in a **Liturgy of the Word**, and not Mass.

Please do not confuse the two sacraments of **Marriage** and **Eucharist**. They each stand on their own and in no way depend upon each other. A marriage is valid even if it is not celebrated within Mass.
